**Appliqué In A Day** **Monday** **10:30-4:30**  
**Mary Arnold** **August 1** **\$35 +\$10 lab fee**  
Learn several appliqué techniques in one day, from freezer paper to needle turn. And the best part is you only need to bring scissors as all supplies will be provided in the kit purchased on the day of the class.

**Autumn Leaves** **Thursday** **1:00-4:00**

Make beautiful leaves using Ruth McDowell's piecing method. Use the leaves for placemats, table runner, or quilt.

**Between Friends** **Saturday** **1:00-3:00**

Another fun and quick quilt from the designer of Yellow Brick Road – Terry Atkinson. Make it in either the larger block size (Between Friends) or the smaller block size (Between Friends Junior) as shown in the sample. Both quilts from the book “Happy Hour”. Suitable for all skill levels.

What a striking quilt for very little effort! Fast and easy, this quilt is suitable for all skill levels. Linda has special cutting instructions to save time and fabric.

**Fractured Images** **Thursday** **10:30-4:30**

Want to learn how to create this interesting effect that makes your fabric appear to vibrate? If you like surprises, this is a class for you. We'll make a wall hanging that will amaze all of us. Plan on getting most of the top put together during our class time. Just be forewarned: you won't be able to stop with just one.

**Garden Patch Cats** **Tuesday** **1:00-4:00**

Cats, cats, cats! Helene Knott's cats are adorable and fun to make. Choose any of her mischievous pussies to appliqué. The border frames the block so that it may be used as a stand-alone piece, or become part of a larger quilt. Class will cover raw-edge, machine, and hand appliqué techniques, depending on class participants' interests.

**Quilted Postcards** **Saturday** **1:00-4:00**

Make a quilted postcard with the author of "Positively Postcards!" . Postcards are not only fun, they offer a great opportunity to "test drive" some creativity and art-quilt techniques that one might be reluctant to try on a larger scale. Most of the 86 postcards in the book will be available for examination, along with dozens that have actually gone through the mail.

You will complete one card during the three-hour class (after that, most can be made in one hour or less). Bring your own fabrics, or purchase a kit from Bonnie for \$4 to \$8 (see her website for ideas, [www.quilted-postcards.com](http://www.quilted-postcards.com) ). She also has innards kits for \$4 that includes the stiffener, the batting, fusible, and white fabric for the message-side of the postcard. Supply list will be provided. You will want to bring a machine that does zigzag stitching for the edging. This class is for beginners through advanced quilters.

A new Buggy Barn design! Start it now and have it ready for the holidays. The block is half tree and half Santa. Pick holiday colors in greens, reds, and creams or whites, and have a fun quilt for the holidays!

This quilt looks great in Batiks or Asian fabrics, but any choice you make will look good. Grab a Bali Pop, jelly roll, or 2 ½" strips from your stash and you're ready to go! The piecing accents in the border give this quilt a style of its own.

This is quick project you will finish in one afternoon. Bring two fat quarters and some flannel and you will make this nice thread catcher and pin cushion to have next to your sewing machine.
